HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everday business. How does Civis Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.		
How does Civis Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information information, for example. when you:  Open an account Pay us by check Apply for a loan Provide your mortgage information Give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only:  Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness  Affiliates from using your information to market to you  Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you  State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be either financial and non-financial companies.	
	Civis Bank does not share with our affiliates.	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.

Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
